


## Class - 111 - 118 RANCH TRAIL

## L1 Amateur and Youth will NOT Drag (ride to post - stop then walk around post - stop)



Unless specifically directed, riders should negotiate obstacles and choose the path between obstacles that allows them to best exhibit their horses.

- 1. Start beside plants. Walk over logs and bridge.
- 2. Trot serpentine through plants.
- 3. Lope left lead around cow camp. Change leads. Extend lope around drag. May briefly collect. Walk to drag.
- I. Drag obstacle around trees at walk or trot. Return to original position.
- 5. Extended walk to bales. Back between bales.
- 6. Sidepass between logs.
- 7. Extended trot serpentine through stumps.
- 8. Walk to gate. Ride through.
- 9. Extended walk to bales. Stop. Dismount. Ground tie. Ring dinner bell. Lead horse out of bales. Pattern is complete.

<u>Note</u>: The drawn description of this pattern is only intended for the general depiction of the pattern. Riders should use the space as needed to best exhibit their horses.
